Transporter Staging	<p>Transporter Staging is located at the southwest corner of the intersection of 16th Street and Polco Street just outside of Main Gate. This staging location is outside the IMS track and is open to the public (no security). Teams arriving on September 29th should remain in this staging area until released to the paddock area for load in scheduled for 12:00pm on the 29th. Competent Motorsport staff will direct teams to transporter parking area just outside garage/paddock area.</p> <p>Teams arriving prior September 29th may elect to park at this transporter staging area or park elsewhere and return to the staging area on the 29th for load in.</p>
Transporter Parking	Access to the paddock begins 12:00pm – 8:00pm on September 29 th for teams. Paddock parking will be directed by Competent Motorsport staff. Transporters will park outside the paddock area in the INDY assigned area for parking of Transporters; the teams will then move their cars/pit equipment, etc. to their assigned garages.

Rule Amendments	<p>The sections listed below are rule amendments and/or additions to the current 2022 General and Sporting Rules, and Technical Regulations. We have identified which rules are changes to the existing referenced section or a new section to be added.</p> <p>For the Indianapolis Motor Speedway event (September 30th – October 2nd) the Supercup Exhaust System will be allowed on GT3 Cup Platinum cars.</p> <p>Section 2.2.3 in the Platinum Technical Regulations has been amended to read:</p> <p>2.2.3 Exhaust system</p> <p>The exhaust system, starting from the manifold, for the Competent Motorsport Yokohama Drivers Cup USA will be OEM as delivered with the rear silencer and parts listed in the valid parts catalogue for the respective car and model year to the version</p> <p>At certain racetracks, to be articulated in the Supplemental Regulations for these specific events, the exhaust system, starting from the manifold, may be modified completely with the parts listed in the valid parts catalogue for the respective Car and Model year to the version “exhaust system without silencer” (general linguistic usage as “Supercup exhaust system”).</p> <p>TIRE ALLOCATION – Technical Summary (Section 15.2) and General and Sporting (12.1.2) Regulations:</p> <p>Tires used during any Official Event session must be the Spec Tire of the Series. Drivers are allowed four (4) sets of Dry Tires for a standard three (3) day event whether you are running in a two (2) or three (3) race event. As a new platform, GT3 Cup 992 cars are allowed six (6) sets of Dry Tires for a standard two (2) race event until further notice. All tires for the event to be used for QUALIFYING and RACE must be STAMPED by the Yokohama authorized distributor at the track. PRACTICE sessions do not require STAMPING; however, all tires must be Yokohama Advan Slicks from the authorized distributor. Tires used in each individual RACE must be the same tires used in the associated QUALIFYING session. If there is in no QUALIFYING session for a RACE, any approved named Spec Tire of the Series may be used. If a tire becomes unsafe; driver/team might take it to distributor and purchase a replacement tire to</p>



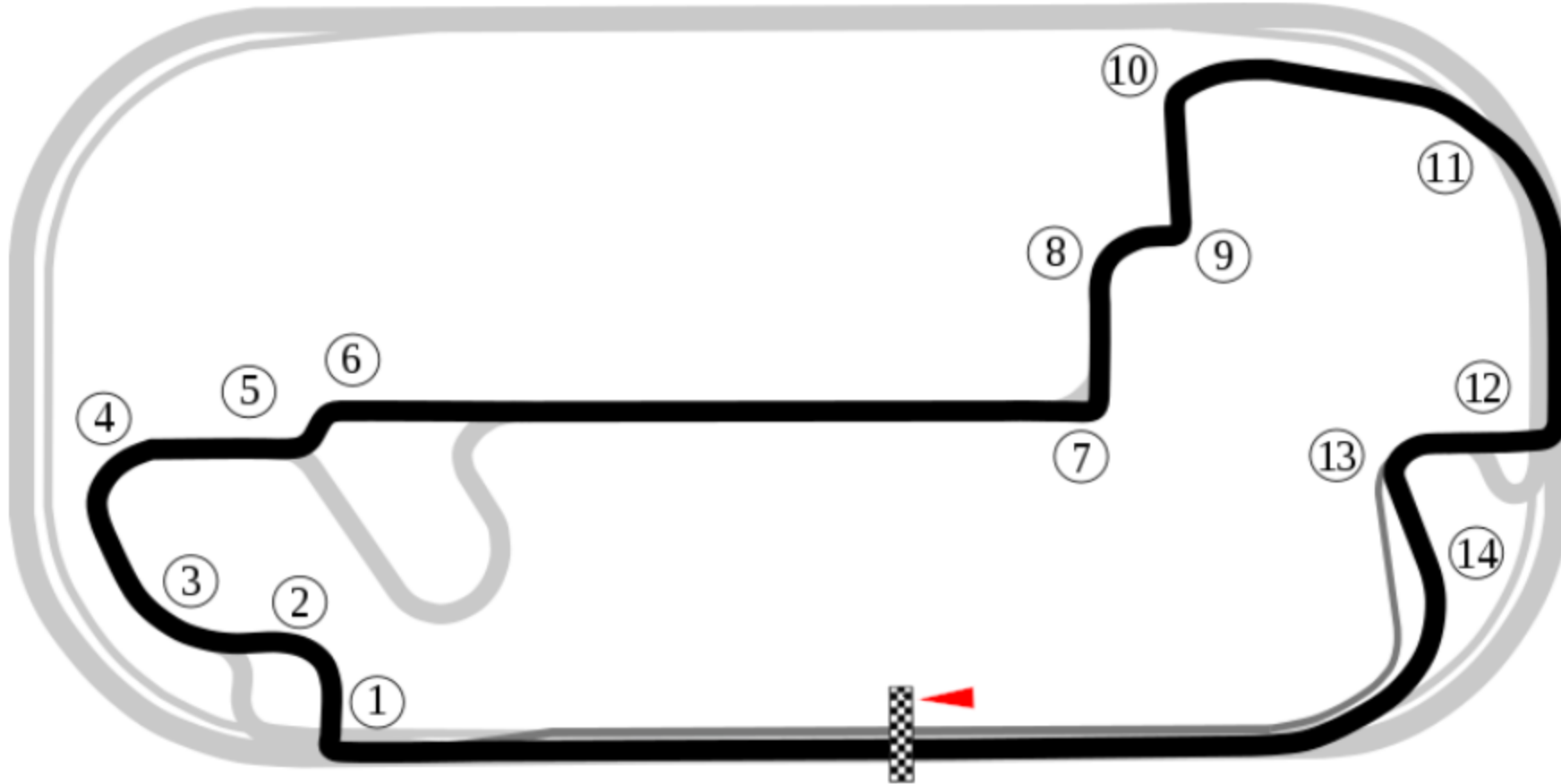
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	<p>replace the unsafe tire. Prior to tire replacement, the unsafe tires must be taken to the Series Technical Director to get replacement approval. A car replacing only ONE tire after qualification will be allowed to retain its original starting position. A car replacing TWO tires after qualification will be given a 5-grid spot penalty. A car replacing more than two tires after qualification will start at the back of the grid. Any tire purchases above the allotted amount for a given event must be pre-approved by the Series Technical Director.</p> <p><i>Sections Fueling 8.16.2 and 8.16.4.4 Pit Lane Regulations have been amended to read:</i></p> <p>Fueling 8.16.2: There is no refueling, or fuel transfer permitted in the pit lane unless specifically allowed in the SR's. All refueling must be done in the competitor's paddock space; the person fueling the car must wear a fire-resistant suit meeting SFI 3.2A specification, shoes, socks, gloves, and balaclava meeting SFI 3.3 specification, and wear full fire-resistant head gear (helmet with the visor down) and be attended by a dedicated individual manning a fire extinguisher. Fueling inside garages is not allowed. Any infraction of these rules will be assessed <u>\$400</u> per incident.</p> <p>8.16.4.4 Pit Lane Regulations Refueling may only be done in the competitor paddock. No fuel may be added to the car in the pit lane or on the racetrack unless specifically allowed in the SR's. If refueling is allowed in pit lane by the SR's, the car must be attended by a dedicated individual manning a fire extinguisher. Both the person fueling the car and the person manning the fire extinguisher must wear a fire-resistant suit meeting SFI 3.2A specification, shoes, socks, gloves and balaclava meeting SFI 3.3 specification, and wear full fire-resistant head gear (helmet with the visor down). 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Appendix C – Indianapolis Motor Speedway Facility Policies

The following items are **prohibited** through Indianapolis Motor Speedway gates:

- Aerosol cans.
- Animals (except service animals providing assistance to an individual with a disability).
- BBQs – **no** BBQs allowed
- Coolers larger than 18" x 14" x 14".
- Drones and similar remote-controlled devices.
- Fireworks and flares.
- Flagpoles.
- Glass containers.
- Golf carts.
- Illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia.
- Lasers of any kind.
- Roller blades, skateboards, skates, hover boards and scooters.
- Sampling or flyers of any kind.
- Scaffolding or platforms.
- Selfie sticks.
- Stickers.
- Weapons of any type, including knives, firearms, and ammunition.
- Any other items not mentioned that may pose a safety hazard or diminish the enjoyment of the event by other guests.

The following items are **permitted** through Indianapolis Motor Speedway gates:

- Audio and video recording equipment.
- Binoculars, scanners and cameras.
- Camelbacks.
- Camera stands (tripods, monopods) as long as they do not cause a safety hazard or obstruct the view of others.
- Carts and wagons. The use of carts and wagons may be restricted in some areas.
- Coolers no larger than 18"x14"x14", coolers may be hard or soft sided.
- Flags as long as they do not obstruct the view of others.
- Food and beverages.
- Mobility aids used by guests with disabilities. Guests are responsible for securing unattended wheelchairs and scooters. IMS reserves the right to prohibit any device based on size or other considerations.
- Strollers, lawn chairs and folding camping chairs.
- Umbrellas as long as they do not obstruct the view of others. The umbrella's user takes sole responsibility for the safe use of the umbrella.

Smoking Policy

- Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes, vaporizers or similar products will not be permitted in IMS grandstands. Fans wishing to smoke may do so twenty feet away from buildings and seating entrances.
